## Itinerario ampliado

## **Extended itinerary**

#### Day 1.

We will pick you up at the Barajas airport or train station, visit the Prado Museum and stroll through the most endearing places in the city.

### Day 2.

Crossing the Guadarrama tunnel, we will go to the walled city of Ávila. We will walk through ancient streets and walls, discovering charming corners such as the Cathedral Square, Italy or Santa Teresa squares, surrounded by old monasteries and other ancient monuments. From here, we will go to Salamanca, awaits one of the oldest universities in Europe. It is more than eight centuries old. We will tell you about a famous game for those who visit the façade: to find a famous frog on it. We will enter the Cathedral, old and new part, and we will walk through the city, where we will enjoy one of the most beautiful squares in Spain and take our souvenir photos.

#### Day 3.

We will start our way to the North and meet the ancient city of Zamora and river Duero, whose origins go back to the Bronze Age (its historic center is a jewel of Romanesque art) and we will walk through its streets and walls. We will visit its cathedral culminated by an impressive dome.

We will leave for León and stop for lunch in the city of Benavente.

We will take contact with nature in our visit to the caves of Valporquero. And we will return to the city that emerged as the camp of the VI Roman Legion and became the Middle Ages capital of the kingdom of its name. In it we will enjoy visiting such artistic places as the Palace of the Guzmanes, the Casa de Botines and, especially, its famous cathedral. Inside we will contemplate the rays of the sun coming through its impressive stained glass.

#### Day 4.

On our trip to Coruña, we will stop at Las Médulas, a spectacular natural area originated by the exploitation of a gold mine by the Romans. Then we will arrive to the city of Lugo surrounded by the oldest Roman wall of the world, in which we will enjoy a pleasant walk. From there we will go to Santiago de Compostela, the destination city of European pilgrims from the first epochs of Christianity, where we will eat and visit its cathedral.

In Coruña, the bimillennial Tower of Hercules, the oldest Roman lighthouse in the world and the only one in service. We will walk through the port and the beautiful city center impregnated by the scent of the sea. We will have dinner in a city restaurant.

#### Day 5

Very early in the morning, from the coasts of the Atlantic Ocean, winding through its spectacular estuaries, we will go to the Cantabrian Sea, not without visiting the city of El Ferrol beforehand, with a magnificent port defended by forts and walls.

We will pass through a multitude of charming villages and coves along the Cantabrian Corniche until we reach Oviedo. Oviedo it the former capital of the Kingdom of Asturias, the point of origin of the uprising against the Arab conquerors. We will walk through the city and visit its cathedral. Next, go to the neocueva of Altamira, (possible visit with previous reservation at the request of the travelers). In Santander we will get lost in its street, contemplate façades that look out to the sea, the port and beaches. We will stroll until we reach El Sardinero beach.

#### Day 6

In the morning we will go to Bilbao and visit the city center. Then we will go to Vitoria and enjoy touring the city and eat.

We will cross moors and vineyards from which the famous Rioja wine is extracted while we continue our journey towards Burgos, where we will visit its beautiful cathedral, considered by many the best example of Spanish Gothic art. We will walk through its streets and enjoy its fabulous cuisine while we dine in one of the city typical restaurants.

### Day 7.

Departure to the current capital of Castilla-León, Valladolid, birthplace of King Felipe II, and who had under his crown the greatest empire in the history of the world. Valladolid was its capital at that time. In our journey we will cross the plains of old Castile where cereals are grown and we will see their leafy vineyards that produce one of the most important wines of the country, the Ribera de Duero, one of whose wineries we will visit. In Palencia is the first University of Spain and one of the oldest in the world. We will visit its cathedral "Bella desconocida" and enjoy a meal in a typical place. In Valladolid we will visit the Oriental Museum and stroll through its Plaza Mayor, the beautiful Plaza de San Pablo where we can contemplate the façades of its magnificent buildings and visit some of them, and the most typical streets flanking it.

Day 8.

Back to Madrid we will pass through Tordesillas, where "Juana la Loca" died, heir of the Catholic Monarchs and we will visit the Castle of La Mota, with its magnificent Homage Tower. There Queen Isabella the Catholic was born. We will pass by another important castle, the one of Coca and we will arrive to the city of Segovia where we will contemplate the imposing Roman Aqueduct and visit the magnificent cathedral and El Alcázar. Once in Madrid, we will have dinner at a typical restaurant.

Day 9. In the morning, we will visit the Prado Museum, one of the main art galleries of the world. In the afternoon, the Royal Palace and then we will have free time\* to dedicate it to shopping. You can count on our guidance.

Day 10. We will accompany you to the airport to wish you a happy return trip.
